

King David could be quite an enthusiastic person. He had kind of a

rough life as an outlaw tribal chief for a while. But once he became King of Israel, he celebrated the Lord with happiness, love and joy. The Ark of the Covenant was at the house of Obed-edom. David pitched a special tent for the ark, and it



was moved to Jerusalem. As the Ark processed and entered the city, David celebrated. He loved the glory of the Lord. He joined in the procession, he wore a robe of fine linen and ephod. Saul's daughter Michal, David's wife saw all this going on. She wasn't participating, but did bother to look out the window. What did she think about David's worship? She didn't have a clue, but instead "despised him in her heart." (I Chronicles 15:29) But David carried on, and gave a sincere prayer of praise and thanksgiving two chapters over in 1 Chronicles 17:16-27. In that time with God, David spoke of knowing God, and being known by God.

Years ago one of our famous Baptists wrote that "worship is the engine of mission." If Christian mission and outreach has something that makes it go, that something must be true worship!
